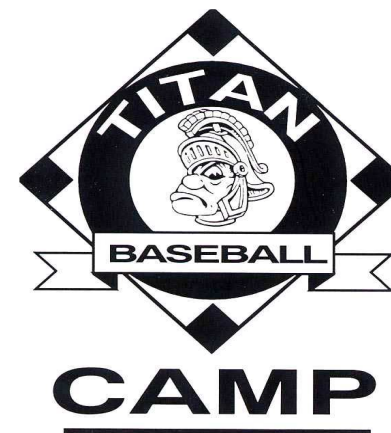

PITCHERS & CATCHERS CAMP is to specialize on these two areas only and is strictly a defensive camp. Campers will be taught how to block pitches, the mechanics of throwing, stance and footwork for a catcher. Pitchers will be drilled in the fundamentals of the mechanics of pitching such as dealing with grips, situation pitching and a variety of other drills for each camper to take with them.

The HITTERS CAMP is just that—two hours each day of swinging and hitting. Drills will be taught and the swing broken down. We guarantee that your child will notice a dramatic improvement in their hitting after this camp. We urge you to bring your bat for this camp.

The COMBO CAMP is 2 days of pitching & catching and 2 days of hitting.

WHAT TO BRING

Campers are required to have only a glove. Caps, spikes or tennis shoes and baseball pants are recommended, if available. A camp T-shirt will be provided. Please circle your t-shirt size listed on the camp registration form.

CAMP INFORMATION

AGES:

Age 7 through 15 years old.
