~ **What can I learn at from the website?**

~ **What if I get injured?**

- Titan Soccer Team Camp employs a fully certified athletic trainer present at each site. The AT will be able to provide ice, tape for ankles and injury and first line of care in case of injury.

~ **Who are the coaches that work the camp?**

- College coaches are used. In previous years we have used coaches from NCAA Division I, II, III and Junior Colleges for our staff. These coaches bring a wealth of knowledge and experience to the fields.
